



It's time to get a flu shot! The flu vaccine is recommended **every year** for adults and children 6 months and older to reduce the risk of developing flu-related illness. CDC guidelines state that routine vaccination should be maintained or reinitiated during the COVID-19 pandemic and is essential for protecting individuals and communities from vaccine-preventable diseases and outbreaks.

Flu shots are available at select JPS Medical Homes throughout Tarrant County. For those without insurance or who wish to pay out-of-pocket, the cost is **\$25**.

You can get a flu shot during a medical appointment at JPS, at appointments with a clinical pharmacist, or you can call 817-702-1100 to make a flu shot appointment at a medical home with a nurse. This year, JPS is also offering drive-thru flu shots for adults 13 years and older.

Drive-Thru Flu Shot Clinics:

Starting September 14th through October 23rd drive-thru flu shots will be available from 8:30am-11am and 1pm-4pm at these medical homes by appointment or drive-in. Children under age 13 will be administered in clinic.
